\_\_\_\_\_**FAIR HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

minor irregularities of the hip joint conformation as  
compared with other individuals of the same  
breed and age

\_\_\_\_\_**BORDERLINE HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

marginal hip joint conformation of indeterminate  
status with respect to hip dysplasia at this time --  
Repeat study in six months

\_\_\_\_\_**MILD HIP DYSPLASIA**

radiographic evidence of minor dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints

\_\_\_\_\_**MODERATE HIP DYSPLASIA**

well defined radiographic evidence of dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints

\_\_\_\_\_**SEVERE HIP DYSPLASIA**

radiographic evidence of marked dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints
